ABOUT US

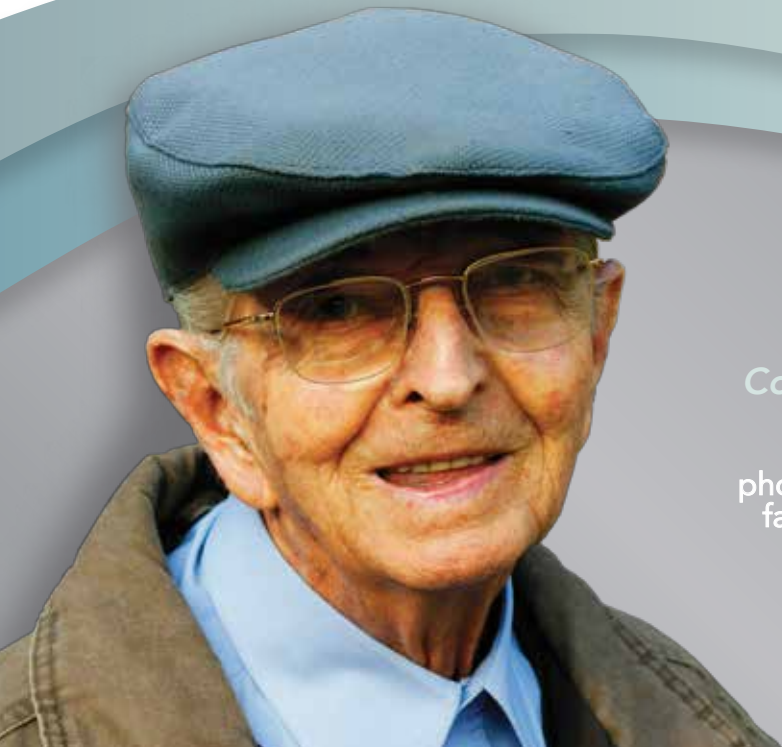

SERVICES

GUARDIAN OF PERSON, ESTATE AND/OR CONSERVATOR

Provide professional and confidential services to individuals with development disabilities, mental illness, infirmities of aging and minors who have been deemed incompetent by a court of law in accordance with Wisconsin State Statutes Chapter 54 and 85.

TRUSTEE

Assisting those who have assets in a trust with the fiduciary management of the assets held within the trust and decisions pertaining to the management of those assets.

PERSONAL REPRESENTATIVE

Available to assist individuals/families with the closing of an estate after the death of a loved one. For estates in excess of \$50,000 we work in conjunction with an attorney as is required by state law.

SPECIAL ADMINISTRATION

Assist with closing of the estates for those individuals who have assets of \$50,000 or less.

GUARDIANSHIP CONSULTANTS

Provide support to those who have been appointed to serve as guardian of person and/or estate for an individual but who may be unfamiliar with the roles and regulations concerning that appointment. Our staff does not give legal advice and adheres to the standards of practice as endorsed by the NGA and the WGA.

POWER OF ATTORNEY

Available to be appointed as power of attorney for those without family willing or able to assist. This is an alternative option for a professional, neutral third party to handle your affairs as you have determined they should be handled. There is no fee for this service until activation of the POA documents occurs.

CASE MANAGERS

Our staff are able to guide individuals with managing their financial affairs as it relates to navigating the complex systems of Medicare, Medicaid and Social Security. They also assist by linking persons transitioning from an independent living to a higher level of support with home care agencies, assisted living facilities and/or nursing homes. Our case managers assist those unfamiliar with the community resources and funding programs to assist with securing benefits.
